

# Project 3 – Mix – A – Speech

Please follow these step-by-step instructions for editing your audio files in Soundtrap.

You will first need to click the Soundtrap link to join the project:

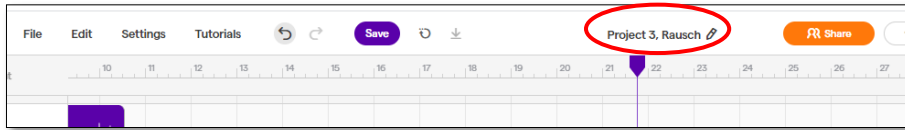

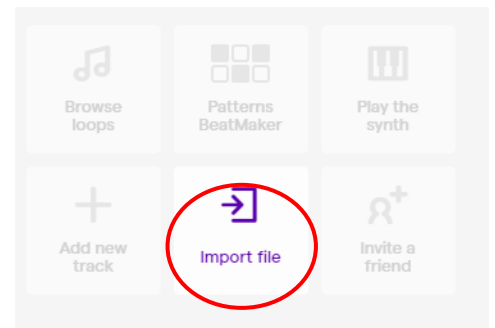
## PART 1 – IMPORTING YOUR SPEECH CLIPS

STEP 1: Change your project name to: "Last Name, Project 3" (Rausch, Project 3).

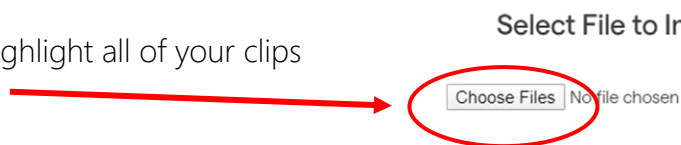


Click "Save" when finished.

STEP 2: Click "Import Files" to bring in ALL of your "speech clips"



STEP 3: Click "Choose Files." You may highlight all of your clips To bring into Soundtrap.

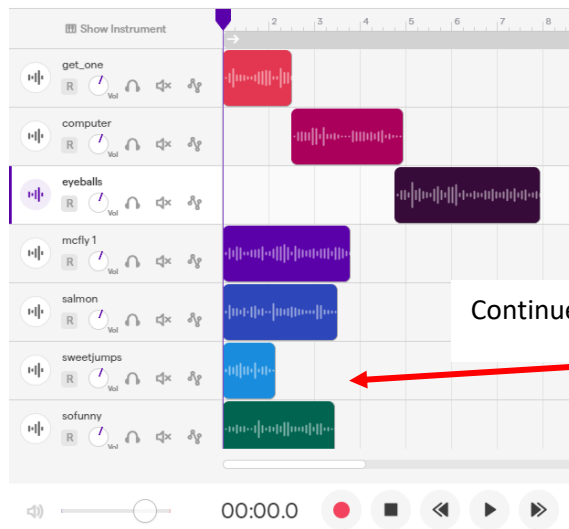


STEP 4: All of your clips will show upon separate tracks (Fig 1). You will need to move each clip over so that each one starts as the previous clip ends (Fig 2.).

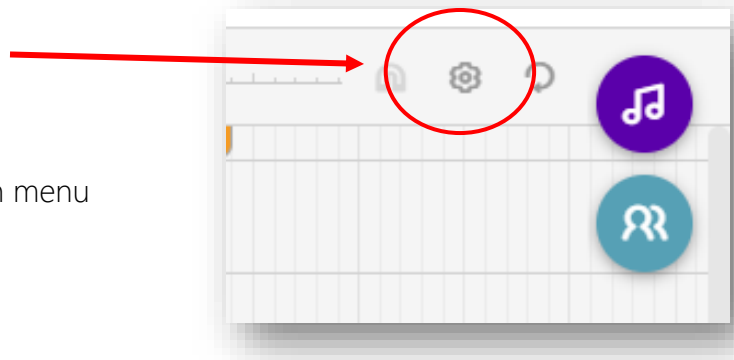

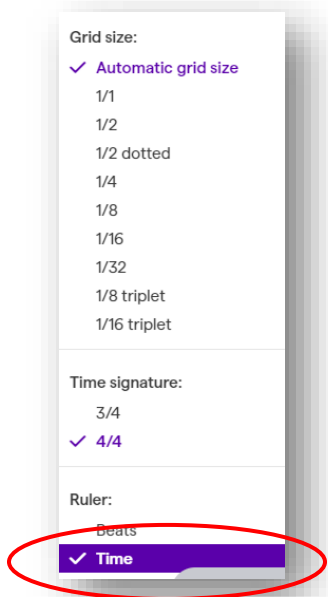


## PART 2 – EDITING YOUR MUSIC TRACKS!

STEP 1: Click the Setting icon to change the layout



STEP 2: Choose 'Time' from the bottom of drop down menu



**STEP 3:** Choose the handle icons at the beginning and end of each clip to drag the length longer or shorter. **MAKE SURE YOUR CLIPS ARE 10-15 SECONDS IN LENGTH.** Use the timing indicator at the top to show you the overall timing of each clip and the project length.

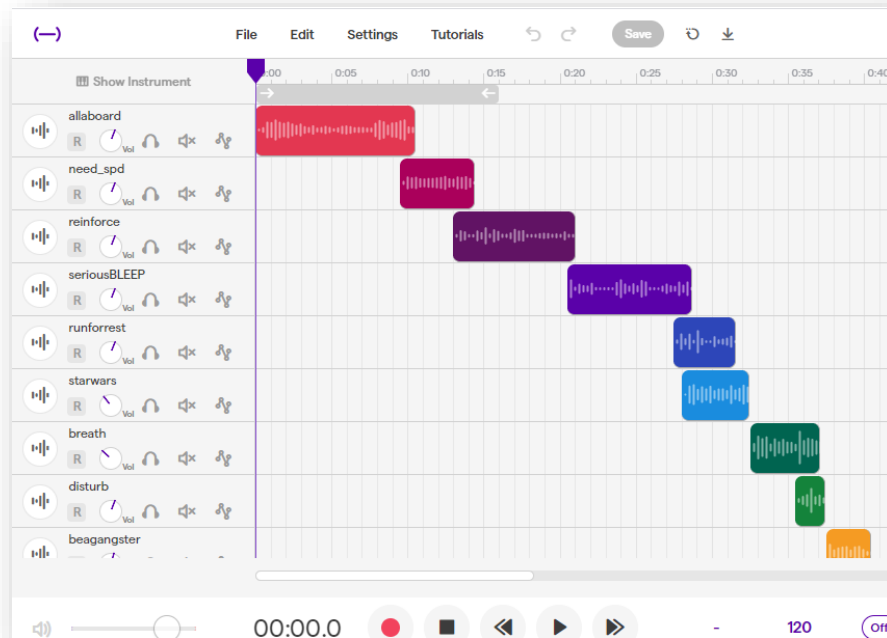


\*Continue editing so that the clips play from left to right. You will need to adjust each track for volume and any other effects that you choose to enhance the sound.

**\*\*\*IMPORTANT\*\*\***

The goal is to have ALL of the tracks be at the same volume level. You will need to adjust each track accordingly!!!!

YOUR PROJECT WILL START TO LOOK LIKE THIS:



**STEP 4:** You will import your choice of audio to be used. The music should match your project theme. You may choose an audio track from YOUTUBE ([Click Here for directions on how to download](#))

Your audio file will be imported the same way as above. Please keep your audio track volume LOWER than your speech clips. Do not let the audio track overpower what is being played on each of the speech tracks.
