HORN FINGERING CHART How To Read The Chart

Since the Double Horn is now in common use the following chart contains fingerings for both the F Horn and the Bb Horn. The use of the Bb Horn allows for greater accuracy in the high register and facilitates tone production in the low register. Not all tones are practical on the Bb Horn, however, because of intonation problems.

Many players prefer to use their Bb Horn when they reach second line G# and continue to use it throughout the upper register.

The Bb Horn is also employed from low F down to low C.

If you have a Double Horn your teacher will advise you when to use it. When playing lip slurring exercises in this book the fingerings indicated are for F Horn.
