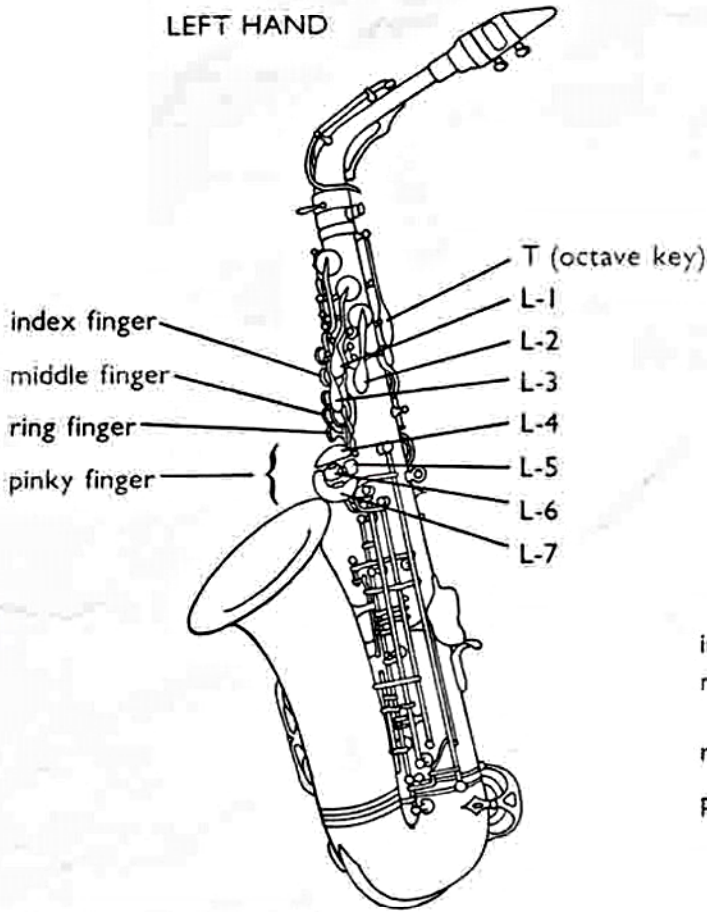


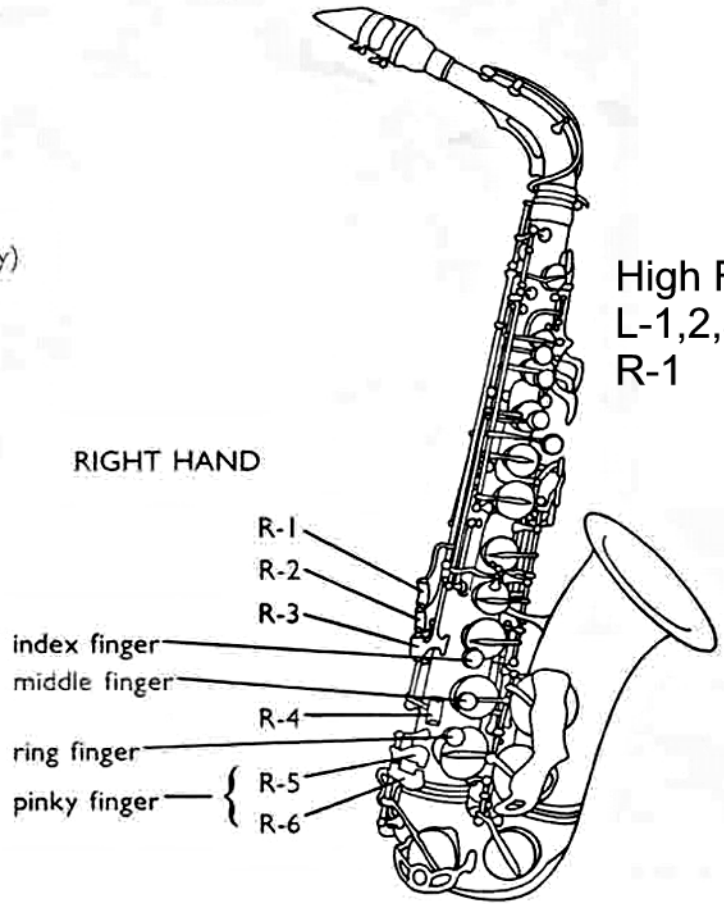
Saxophone Fingering Chart

Row 3: F \sharp , G \flat , G, G \sharp , A \flat , A, A \sharp , B \flat , B, C, C \sharp , D \flat , D, D \sharp , E \flat

Fingering diagrams for each note are provided below the staff lines, using dots for pressed keys and circles for open keys. Fingerings include L-1 through L-7, R-1 through R-6, and T (octave key).
